



FCSI 2010 CONFERENCE GRANTS

Foodservice Consultants Society International

Consultant members of FCSI may be eligible for a conference grant of \$1,000US. Thanks to the generosity of the FCSI Educational Foundation and our Corporate members there are grants available to help defray the cost of attending the Minneapolis conference on March 18, 19 and 20, 2010 at the Hyatt Hotel in Minneapolis. The Educational Foundation has offered twenty \$500 US grants to be matched by \$500US grants from corporate member companies.

To be eligible for and receive one of these \$1,000US grants the individual must be:

- An associate, senior associate or professional consultant member in good standing.
- A first time attendee at an FCSI Division or Worldwide Conference OR someone who may have attended in the past but not in the last 3 years.

The grants can be used to cover:

- Registration Fee (includes conference meals)
- Hotel nights at the conference hotel
- Economy class airline, rail, bus service OR auto transportation to and from your home city and the conference city. Auto is reimbursed at the then current US government reimbursement rate per mile.

Depending upon where you live the grant may or may not cover all of your registration, lodging and transportation. Only the actual expenses will be reimbursed. Any expenses over the \$1,000US are the responsibility of the recipient.

Only one grant will be awarded to each consulting firm unless there are unused grants at the deadline on December 15, 2009. If there are excess grants at that time a second grant may be awarded to a second individual in one firm.
